As an ID card holder, you can travel with us and invite guests as long as they are registered on the access roster of Rose Barracks, Tower Barracks and Hohenfels at least 72 hours prior to the trip. Please note that trip assistants are required to ask for your passport before boarding the bus, as per European law in case of police check. Maintain receipts of your purchases abroad for checks by customs offices. Keep some respective currency for the trip with you at all times as ATM machines are not available everywhere.

PAYMENT POLICIES

REFUND POLICY

- Original receipt is required when asking for refunds.
- No refund for no show.
- Refund is forfeited if not claimed within 300 calendar days of trip registration date.

DAY TRIP REFUND POLICY

- Cancellation up to three working days prior to trip: 100% refund.
- Cancellation two working days prior to trip: 50% refund.
- Cancellation one working day prior to or day of trip: No refund.

OVERNIGHT REFUND POLICY

- A (non-refundable) deposit of \$100 per child and \$150 per adult is required upon registration.
- 30 days prior to the trip's departure date: A minimum of 50% of the trip cost is required. At this time the deposit is not refundable due to contractual obligations with hotels and other agencies.
- 14 days prior to the trip's departure date: The remaining balance of the trip cost is required.
- Cancellation up to 31 days OR per the contractor established deadline prior to a trip's departure date: A full refund will be issued unless otherwise indicated.
- Cancellation within 30 days of the trip's departure date: The amount refunded depends on the specific hotel's cancellation policy. The administration fee of \$150 deposit per adult will not be refunded, unless the cancellation reason is supported by documentation that is signed by a commanding officer or physician. Customers will only receive refunds if their balance paid exceeds the obligation to our contractors. Only the fees paid exceeding our costs will be refunded.
- Soldiers must have leave forms approved prior to the 30 day cancellation date.
- If ODR staff cancels the trip, all customers providing their original registration receipt will receive a full refund.
- ODR reserves the right to forfeit any reservation that does not pay the balances due at the specified times prior to the trip's departure date as stated above.

PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

Travel passports are required for all trips leaving Germany; however, for customers in possession of a passport other than U.S. or European, special considerations must be observed. It is the responsibility of the individual customer to ensure they have all appropriate Visas necessary for entry to countries traveled by Leisure Travel Services during the trip. LEISURE TRAVEL DAY

STEAM TRAIN AND CAVE

MAY 12 | JUNE 9 & 23

Experience the beauty and grandeur of the Frankische Schweiz through the window of an early 20th Century Steam Train traveling up the beautiful Wiesent Valley. Start the morning with a round-trip steam train ride lasting approximately one hour. Enjoy lunch at a traditional Frankische beer keller along the shore of the Wiesent River. Then, venture onto a tour of the Teufelshohle (Devil's Cave), which is a naturally formed limestone cave. While exploring the cave system, descend 400 steps deeper into the caverns filled with stalactites and stalagmites that are between 10 and 200,000 years old. End the day with an exhilarating alpine coaster experience which is 3,500 ft in length and totals an elevation change of more than 900 feet. FIVE BREWERIES HIKE

The Funf Seidla Steig (Five Beer Hike) is an approximately 12 kilometer brewery hike located in the Little Swiss region of Upper Franconia, which travels through beautiful natural surroundings while visiting five traditional Frankish beer breweries. Join Hohenfels Outdoor Recreation as we experience two of Germany's favorite pastimes (hiking & beer) together! Participants who obtain a stamp card at the first location and receive a stamp at every brewery receives a commemorative Funf-Seidla-Steig Beer Krug at the end of their hike. Price: \$59/person

MAY 11 | JULY 20

Explore the wonderful world of lift-accessible mountain biking at one of the oldest mountain bike parks in Europe, the Geisskopf in the Bavarian Forest. With more than 12 separate trails, each 3km in length, the Geisskopf has something for riders of every ability level. Machine cut flow trails, jump lines, technical enduro routes and downhill circuits will aim to please your adventure on two wheels. Price: \$69/person includes transportation, lift ticket, instruction and half price bike rental.

TRAILPARK KLINOVEC*

JUNE 7-9 | JULY 5-7

Bike Park Klinovec in the Czech Republic is the premier destination for a trip exploring the growing sport of lift accessible mountain biking (take a lift up with your bike and ride down – focusing on the fun and less on physical fitness). Trailpark Klinovec has 24km of trails designed for fun in mountain biking and are accessible both to beginners and families (with flowing machine-cut trails devoid of obstacles) and seasoned riders looking for challenging terrain, jump lines and UCI sanctioned downhill courses. Price: \$219/person includes transportation, accommodations, lift tickets and half price bike rental.

PEGNITZ – POTTENSTEIN LOOP

MAY 19

Expert level mountain bike tour through Franconian Switzerland. This loop was rated as one of the top single-track mountain bike tours in the entire country of Germany in 2010. It's a physically demanding tour of 35km with nearly 1000 meters of ascent. Trails consist of root and rock strewn singletrack, gravel roads and loamy forest trails. Price: \$39/person includes transportation, guide, refreshment upon conclusion and half price bike rental.

RENNSTEIG MULTI-DAY MOUNTAIN BIKE ADVENTURE

JUNE 13-16

Join Outdoor Recreation for a multi-day mountain biking adventure on one of the oldest long-distance hiking trails in Germany. The Rennsteig is a 170km hiking trail that follows the old East/West German border between Bavaria and Thuringen and a path deep within fairy-tale forests during the route between the Salle and Werra rivers. Besides the traditional Alpen cross, the Rennsteig is the go-to multi-day mountain bike adventure on the European continent. Although the distance of 170km (100 miles) is a daunting task –breaking down the route into three (3) stages make this an achievable goal for cyclists with moderate levels of fitness and technical riding abilities. Due to the near constant riding surface of roots and rocks, ODR recommends a full-suspension cross-country or all-mountain bicycle with 100-120mm of travel front and rear. Price: \$289/person includes lodging, transportation, shuttling of bags, route guide and half price bike rental.

SINGLETREK POD SMRKEM*

AUGUST 30-SEPTEMBER 2

Singletrek Pod Smrkem is a single track mountain bike trail network and recreation area in the Czech Republic under the majestic mountain of Smrk (Spruce Mountain). The trail network was designed by Welsh trail designer Dafydd Davis who is internationally recognized to be one of the top mountain bike trail builders/designers in the world. The trail center currently has more than 80 km of trail expanding 4 levels of difficulty and accessible to every level of cyclists from families with children to more technically advanced riders such as hobby cyclists and racers. This trail network is popular among European mountain bikers and the perfect location for a weekend on two wheels. Price: \$359/person includes transportation, lodging and half price bike rental.

TANDEM SKYDIVING

APRIL 28 | MAY 5 & 24 | JUNE 2 & 14 | JULY 14 | AUGUST 18 | SEPTEMBER 15 | OCTOBER 6

Imagine doing something that you never expected. Walking out to a plane, loading and traveling up to 14,000 ft. above the Earth's surface. The door opens and everything below is too small for you to recognize. Freefall for approximately 54 seconds at a speed of 120 MPH. Under canopy, enjoy the beautiful views offered only in Bavaria and steer alongside your Tandem-Master as you make your descent back to the drop-zone. Photos, video and other souvenirs are available directly from the drop-zone at additional cost. Call for details.

CLIMBING & ZIPLINE/HIGH ROPES

EVENING OUTDOOR ROCK CLIMBING

FIRST AND THIRD TUESDAY OF EVERY MONTH MAY 7-SEPTEMBER 24 (EXCEPT FEDERAL HOLIDAYS)

Sport Climbing (rock climbing on cliffs with pre-installed protection) is one of the fastest growing adventure sports worldwide that demands both mental and physical fitness. Luckily enough, USAG Bavaria Hohenfels happens to be located near the epicenter of the European climbing scene and one of the largest sport climbing destinations in Central-Europe. Join Outdoor Recreation for our weekly climbing evenings where you learn about equipment, safety systems, efficient movement techniques and mental training for climbing success. Climbing locations change weekly depending on ability levels of participants. Price: \$29 per person with initial block of instruction, \$15 for repeat customers, transportation and gear included

ZIPLINE AND HIGH ROPES ADVENTURE PARK

JUNE 30 | AUGUST 11

Embrace this adrenaline-based nature tour! This trip is designed to get your blood pumping while enjoying the beauty of Germany's forest all at the same time. Spend three hours climbing, flying and negotiating elements through the forest canopy on 16 different routes between tree platforms 20 meters off the ground. Minimum age requirement is 12 years old. Young adults ages 12-17 must have a parent or legal guardian present to sign consent form upon entry to the Adventure Park. Transportation and entry fee included. Registration closes one week before trip date. Price: \$69/person. Transportation from Rose Barracks and Tower Barracks also provided.

** Zip lines are high cable traverses using safety harnesses and associated hardware. The zip line activity begins and ends at the point of assembly. Participants receive orientation and instruction on proper use upon arrival. Due to the strenuous nature of this activity, good physical condition is advised to participate.*



WARRIOR ADVENTURE QUEST

The Warrior Adventure Quest (WAQ) is a DA approved and endorsed program under Executive Orders for all units. WAQ is designed to re-create the adrenaline rush of combat action in a supervised, controlled, high adventure activity which is supervised by Outdoor Recreation staff.

WAQ instills cohesion, builds teamwork and maintains combat readiness through high-adventure activities. This program enables Soldiers to reach a “new stage of normal” by diminishing boredom and high-risk behavior, through outdoor recreation and a Leader – Led After Action Debriefing L-LAAD.

WAQ is offered at no cost to units. All units are now eligible for participation. Non-deploying units can attend once every two years. Units within 120 days prior to a deployment or 120 days after a deployment may attend during that time frame. Funding is provided upon successful completion of the activity and fulfillment of Post-Activity Survey.

All WAQ activities take place on weekdays, during regular duty hours. This program is not to be confused as a free recreation day. Please do not schedule a WAQ activity day in conjunction with any other event i.e. unit organization day, FRG gathering, family days, Army birthdays, promotion ceremonies, bake sales, etc. Distractions like these cause the activity day to be cancelled.

The WAQ program is a Leader and Soldier Program designed to support the Ready/Train and RESET phases of the ARFORGEN process. The objective of WAQ is to create a sustainable, enduring program that Army leaders recognize as a viable means to assist Soldier re-integration, maintain combat readiness and increase unit cohesion. Each activity is followed by a (L-LAAD) and Post- Activity survey. This is designed to draw similarities between the high adventure activity and their Warrior experiences. The L-LAAD is conducted by unit leadership (Squad Leader, NCOIC, OIC, Commander, etc.) The designated L-LAAD facilitators need to meet with a WAQ representative the day prior to the event. WAQ representatives will teach the leaders how to properly conduct an L-LAAD.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR UNIT PARTICIPATION

1. Unit Designated Training Coordinators (PSG/PL or higher) contact USAG Bavaria Outdoor Recreation Warrior Adventure Quest to schedule activity 3 weeks prior to selected date.
 - Execution: Target train/ready units within 120 days of deployment, RESET units within 120 days of redeployment and units with no impending deployment
 - Group size: Limited to one platoon (30-40 people) per day
 - Activity duration: 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. (one hour for lunch)
2. Dates provided on a first come, first-served basis. Activities include but are not limited to:

UNIT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Confirm unit has a facilitator present for the Leader-Led After Action Debriefing (L-LAAD) Training.
- Conduct Soldier Training prior to attendance: Information on why the Army is providing WAQ.
- Each Soldier is required to complete a WAQ post-survey on the day of the scheduled activity. This tracks Soldiers in attendance and funding.

KAYAK IN LITTLE SWITZERLAND

APRIL 10 & 24 | MAY 8 & 22 | JUNE 12 & 26 | JULY 10 & 24 | AUGUST 14 & 28 | SEPTEMBER 11 & 25

Give SCUBA diving a try with the Hohenfels Outdoor Recreation this season. This introductory course takes place at a local indoor/outdoor swimming pool depending on weather.
